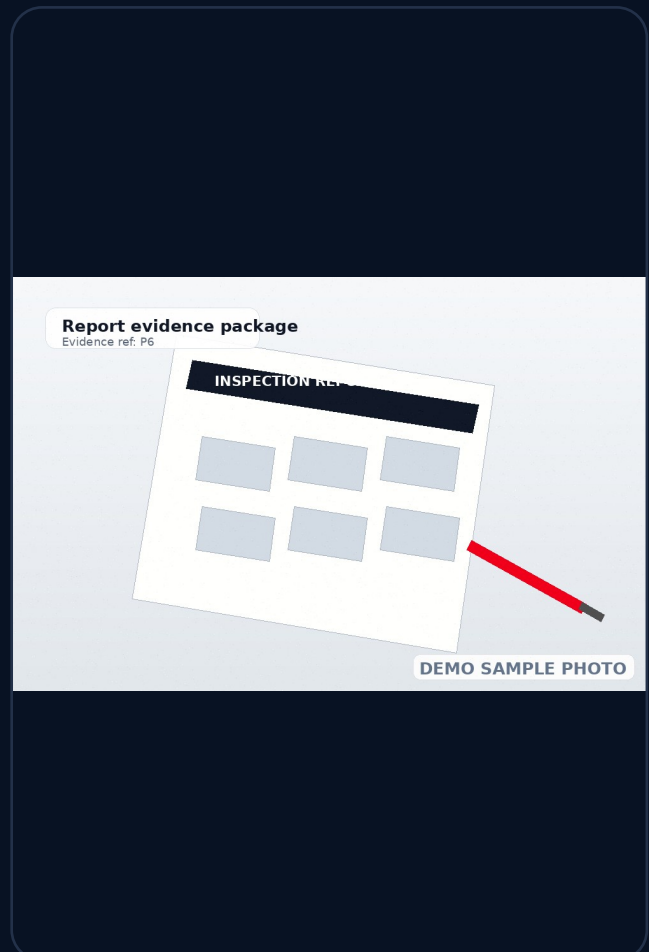

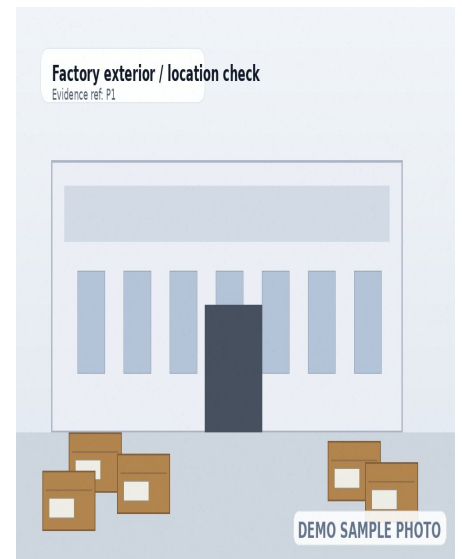
The report is not showing a disaster. It is showing a manageable problem that should be corrected first.

Question	Suggested answer
Can the buyer pay now?	No — wait for corrected carton label evidence.
Can pickup be released?	Not yet — request new packaging photos first.
Does the supplier need rework?	Yes — fix carton label inconsistency across all export cartons.
Is a re-inspection required?	Optional — useful if the order value is meaningful or trust is still low.

Many buyers do not need a complicated AQL textbook. They need a practical answer to “Can I safely pay now?” This page makes that decision easy to understand.

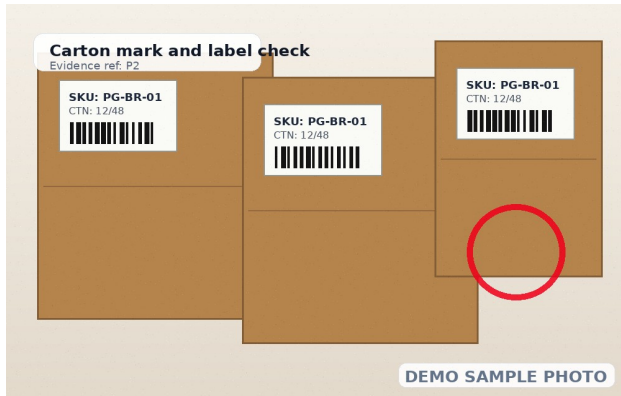
This wording helps the report stay honest and credible. A good sample report should look useful, but it should not overpromise.

4. Main findings and notes

Area	Result	Buyer note
Product appearance	Acceptable	Overall product presentation is acceptable in sampled units.
Simple function	Acceptable	No major functional failure in the checked sample set.
Quantity / assortment	Acceptable	Sampled cartons matched expected assortment.
Retail packaging	Minor issue	One retail box showed a soft corner dent.
Carton labels	Needs correction	The biggest practical issue in this sample. Label formatting / placement was inconsistent.
FBA readiness	Partial	Basic label readiness looks workable, but final FBA requirements depend on buyer workflow.

The report is not trying to find drama everywhere. Most things are acceptable. One issue matters more than the others, and the recommendation reflects that.

5. Packaging and label evidence



Check point	Observation
Inner packing	Generally neat and consistent in sampled units.
Carton structure	Acceptable in sampled cartons.
Carton marks / labels	Inconsistency observed — should be corrected before pickup.
SKU separation	Acceptable in sampled cartons.
Recommended next step	Supplier to relabel or correct all cartons and send a fresh photo set.

For many small importers and marketplace sellers, this is the page that matters most. A minor cosmetic scratch might be acceptable. The wrong carton label can create a shipment headache.

6. Recommended next steps

Priority	Action	Owner
High	Correct carton labels on all export cartons.	Supplier
High	Send updated photos showing the corrected labels.	Supplier
Medium	Replace visibly dented retail boxes during final packing.	Supplier
Medium	Review the updated photos before paying the balance.	Buyer
Optional	Arrange a short re-check if the order is valuable or trust is low.	Buyer / Agent Huang
